## **CPR Training Classes Open to All**

Ocoee, Florida – The City of Ocoee’s Fire Department has expanded its CPR program. All of its life-saving training classes are open to residents *and* non-residents alike. The Ocoee Fire Department is one of only a handful of fire departments in Central Florida that offers all of its CPR training to residents and non-residents.

For anyone wanting to learn basic CPR, the Ocoee Fire Department teaches free classes on the 4<sup>th</sup> Wednesday of each month from 6:00pm-8:30pm. A Heart Saver CPR/AED training is taught on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of each month from 1:00pm – 5:00pm. The cost is \$25. All trainings are held at Fire Station 1, 563 South Bluford Avenue.

The Ocoee Fire Department recently achieved an upgraded status and is now an Advanced Cardiovascular Life Support Training site. As a result, all OFD paramedic recertifications can be completed in-house.

With the new Advanced Cardiovascular Life Support status, the OFD has added several classes to its CPR program.

- Airway Management
