On Saturday May 15, 2010, at ten minutes before 11 a.m., a single black male entered the Bank of America located at 1201 West Colonial Drive in Ocoee. The male presented a note to the teller demanding fifties and hundreds. The note simply stated the teller should comply with his demands if she wanted to go home today. The male then exited the bank on foot toward the rear of the bank where police believe he entered an awaiting vehicle.

Photographs of the male are attached. The male can be seen talking on a cell phone during the robbery. The male may be communicating with a get away driver outside the bank or using the phone as a prop to help conceal his face. Update:

Detectives with the City of Ocoee Police Department have identified Chapelle Teague as the individual who robbed the Bank of America on May 15, 2010. Forensic evidence coupled with video surveillance has confirmed Chapelle Teague, B/M, 1/3/1977 committed the robbery. A felony warrant has been issued for his arrest.
