On December 19, 2010 at approximately 3:00 P.M., A person exposed his sexual organs to a child under the age of 16 by opening his trench coat. The child was attended by the mother. The mother attempted to stop the subject but the subject was able to get away.

Suspect description: W/M, 6'03", medium build, dark hair, ponytail, denim pants, light (possibly gray) shirt with design or print on front, dark (possibly black) trench coat, and dark shoes, (dress or boots.)

The suspect was last seen fleeing eastbound on Colonial drive from the Wal-Mart. The suspect was operating the following vehicle.

Vehicle description: light colored American make car (possibly Pontiac Grand-Am or Grand Prix,) good condition, out-of-state plate (possibly West Virginia or Michigan,) # 8RT-498, Florida Gator tag on front.

The suspect in this case has been identified as David M. Huffman W/M 9/27/1967, a registered sexual offender. Huffman's address is listed as "Transient." City of Ocoee Police Detectives obtained a felony arrest warrant for Huffman charging him with Lewd and Lascivious Exhibition to a Child Under 16 Years of Age. Upon obtaining the warrant an Orange County Sheriff's Office Fugitive Investigator located and arrested Huffman.

Huffman is currently being interviewed by detectives from the City of Ocoee Police Department and the Orange County Sheriff's Office.

A copy of the Wal-Mart surveillance footage showing Huffman leaving the store can be obtained at the City of Ocoee Police Department Records window or after hours with the night shift watch commander.
